### **UPCOMING 6TH GRADE SCHOLAR SUMMER GUIDE**

This past school year, your child had the opportunity to learn a tremendous amount to build on the knowledge from previous years. Some curricula covered during the previous year that require continued retention and repetition in order to be successful in the next grade are listed below.

#### **English Language Arts:**

Determine a theme of a story, drama, or poem
Explain how a narrator's point of view influences how events are told
Compare and contrast stories on the same topic
Quote accurately from a text when drawing inferences
Write opinion, narrative, and informative essays
Use correct conventions when writing and speaking (spelling, capitalization, punctuation, etc.)

#### **Mathematics:**

Students entering 6th grade should know their basic facts (addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division) of whole numbers and decimals. They should also know how to add, subtract, and multiply fractions.

Listed below are some curricula for the upcoming school year that might be a challenge for students and suggestions on how students can prepare this summer.

#### **English Language Arts:**

Write sentences using correct punctuation and capitalization. Explain the function of pronouns and use pronouns effectively. Read fictional and informational texts for understanding. Identify theme and plot in a story.

#### **Mathematics:**

Students will learn about dividing fractions, ratios, integers, coordinate plane, interchange percent/decimal/fraction, area of 2D figures, volume and surface area of 3D figures, box plots/line plots/histograms and statistical measures during their 6<sup>th</sup> grade year.
