

Graduation Ceremonies and Prom 2020

Prom Information

Obion County Central High School and South Fulton High School will be canceling Prom for both schools this year. Due to the social distancing guidelines that have been recommended by federal and state health officials, there is not a date in the foreseeable future that would allow the events to be held under the current guidelines.

Graduation Information

Both High Schools will have Graduation on May 22nd. Each senior will receive 6 tickets to distribute among family and friends. No one will be admitted to either graduation ceremony without a ticket. Each school will have seating designated at their respective venues for guests that keeps with distancing guidelines. South Fulton's Graduation will be at 5:30 pm and Obion County Central's Graduation will be at 7:30 pm. Principals or Counselors will be contacting the seniors with further information about practices, graduation materials, and ticket distribution.
