The Obion County Central High School faculty, administrators, and staff wish to uphold decency and a sense of respect for our graduates at the Obion County Central High School Commencement Exercise.

While it is important to celebrate our graduates, it is imperative that we do so while following the Governor's guidelines. Everyone is asked to cooperate so that we can safely conduct this ceremony.

Ticket Information:

- Each graduating senior may invite 6 guests. Please make sure that your guests know to act in a respectful and dignified manner.
- This graduation contract needs to be turned in the school office *beginning* Monday, May 11, between the hours of 9:00 – 2:00.
- When your contract is returned, along with all debts paid, books returned, etc. the seniors will be given 6 non-transferable tickets. These tickets are non-transferable because of the safety guidelines we are required to follow.
- *Students lacking more than 2 credits will not be given tickets.*
- Because of the current guidelines, the 6 ticket holders will need to sit together. Ticket holders are to sit in their senior's designated area.
- Those needing handicapped seating, need to contact the school office at 731-536-4688 by Monday, May 11, to make sure you reserve that seating.

Graduation Day—Practice and Event:

- Friday, May 22, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. ALL graduating seniors are to be on the football field, ready to practice.
- Graduation will be held, Friday, May 22, 2020 at 7:30 p.m. on the football field. If inclement weather, graduation will be postponed until Friday, June 5, time of practice and graduation will be the same. *If you do not practice, you do not walk.*
- Seniors need to be on the practice football field that evening, May 22, no later than 6:30 p.m. Please be prompt, dressed and ready to line up as practiced. *In case of inclement weather, graduating seniors will meet on June 5 as make-up date, with all times remaining the same.*
- A professional photographer will be on duty for your convenience.

Attire:

- All graduating men will wear dress pants (dark slacks or khaki pants) and a collared shirt. No flip-flops or tennis shoes are allowed. All graduating women will wear dresses. Flip-flops or tennis shoes are not allowed.
- Caps and gowns are to be worn as purchased. Any alteration of the cap or gown is prohibited.

Conduct:

- If you misbehave during the graduation ceremony, you will be escorted off the premises, and you will not receive a diploma the night of graduation. If you are found with contraband at any time prior to, during or immediately following practice or the ceremony, you will be escorted off the premises, and you will not receive a diploma the night of graduation.
