

Obion County Schools Code of Conduct

In a continued effort to provide safe schools for students, the Obion County Board of Education has developed a code of behavior explaining the steps of discipline for unacceptable behavior. The following are levels of misbehaviors which will be addressed by school personnel.

Level 1 Misbehaviors:

- Impede orderly classroom procedures
- Interfere with the orderly operation of the school
- Can be managed by an individual staff member
- Include but are not limited to disturbances, classroom tardiness, and cheating

Level 2 Misbehaviors:

- Disrupt the learning climate of the school
- Are not direct threats to the health and safety of others
- Require corrective action by a staff member
- Include but are not limited to continuation of Level 1 behaviors, and truancy

Level 3 Misbehaviors:

- Are directed against persons or property
- Are not seriously endangering health or safety of others in the school
- Include but are not limited to Level I and II behaviors, fighting, stealing, and threats

Level 4 Misbehaviors:

- Result in violence to person or another's property
- Pose a threat to the safety of others in the school
- Require removal of student from school, intervention of law enforcement, and Board action
- Include but are not limited to unmodified Level 1, 2 or 3 behaviors, extortion, possession/use/transfer of weapons, possession/use of alcohol or drugs
